- Collect, clean, and preprocess large datasets from various sources for analysis and implement data pipelines for real-time market monitoring.
- Apply supervised and unsupervised machine learning algorithms to identify market patterns, competition metrics, and unusual patterns for market segmentation or concentration.
- Use machine learning techniques to detect price-fixing, collusion, and other anti-competitive behaviors.
- iv. Apply predictive models to assess the competitive impact of mergers and acquisitions. Use Natural Language Processing (NLP) to analyze merger documents for anti-competitive clauses or market dominance.
