The Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP) is seeking services of one Legal professional for the post of Legal Consultant on a two years contract basis. The Candidate must have LLB/LLM from HEC recognized university or a reputed foreign university and/or Barrister-at-Law with at least 7 years of experience in litigation.

The candidate must have following professional credentials:

- Understanding of regulatory regime in Pakistan.
- Comprehensive knowledge of competition law, including the Competition Act, 2010, regulations, and related jurisprudence.
- Experience of legislative drafting including rules and regulations.
- Commitment to professionalism, discipline and integrity.
- Excellent written and oral communication, research, interpretation and representation skills.
- Strong leadership and teamwork skills.
- High court license.

Key Responsibilities

The key responsibilities will include:

- Rendering advice on legal and regulatory affairs and perform all necessary acts assigned by the Commission in involving legal issues, as and when directed.
- Drafting and examination of rules, regulations and other legal instruments.
- Providing legal and procedural support to in-house adjudication.
- Representing Commission at various judicial forums/courts, such as high courts.
- Opinion writing on complex corporate issues.
- The candidate must be able to provide technical assistance to Cartel and Trade Abuses Department (C&TA), Office of Fair trade (OFT) and Centre of Excellence in Competition Law enquiries (CECL).
- Perform any other task assigned by the Chairman.

* A competitive salary package will be offered, commensurate with qualification, experience, and knowledge.
