The learned counsel submits that he has tried to contact the appellant but there was no response on his behalf.

We have noticed that a legal lacuna was there in the appeal and the learned counsel was going to move an application for the same but the Tribunal at its own extended the relief to the appellant by directing the impleadment of M/s Master Foods industries, in the array of appellant but it appears that the appellant is no more interested to pursue his appeal. On 13.12.2023, a cost of Rs. 30,000/- was imposed on the appellant but till date that has also not been paid / deposited.

3. In view of the above, we are left with no option but to dismiss the appeal. The amount of costs be also recovered along with the amount of penalty by the CCP. Appeal stands dismissed.
