

Mr. Ahsen Hameed Lillah, Advocate for the appellant along with appellant Kausar Ali, Mr. Hassan Raza, Advocate along with Hafiz Naeem, legal advisor for the CCP. Mr. Abdul Rehman Qureshi and Mr. Talha Abbasi, Advocates for Respondent No-2.

Through this appeal, the order of Competition Commission of Pakistan dated 27.08.2018, whereby penalty of Rs. 500,000/- for violating section 10 (1) (2) (d) was imposed has been called in question.

2. We have heard the learned counsel for the respective parties and on the conclusion of the submissions, learned counsel for the appellant say that the appellant would be contended if the penalty amount of Rs. 500,000/- imposed by the Commission is reduced. We also find mitigating circumstances to reduce the fine. In the circumstance, we while dismissing the appeal would reduce the fine to Rs. 200,000/-. The appellant says that he is a very poor man and not in a position to pay Rs. 200,000/- at a time but he will ensure that Rs. 50,000/- every month is deposited. In the circumstances, let the amount of Rs. 200,000/- be deposited within four months,



i.e., on or before 15.08.2025, failing which the order of the Commission imposing penalty of Rs. 500,000/- shall stand revived.
