

Justice Sajjad Ali Shah, Chairman.


After making initial submissions the Appellant Muhammad Sikander Nagori in Appeal No.06/2025 as well as Muhammad Shakir Gujjar President Dairy and Cattle Farmers Associations, Karachi in Appeal No.07/2025 duly assisted by his counsel Mr. Ghazi Khan submitted that whole situation has arisen owing to the failure of Commissioner Karachi Division to conduct the meeting and to enhance the price of Milk despite repeated request and reminders given by the association for enhancement of the Milk price. After taking into account the cost and expenditure of the Dairy Farmer they could not sell their product on loss, therefore under the compelling circumstances they had no option but to announce the increase in price. Both the appellants stated they would be satisfied if a lenient view is taken and the penalty so imposed be reduced.


We have sifted the record and have come to the conclusion that Competition Commission has taken a lenient view due to failure of the Commissioner, Karachi Division to revise the milk prices timely despite repeated requests by the appellants. Notwithstanding, the violation of Section 4 of Competition Commission Act cannot be ignored. In the circumstances, we while maintaining the impugned order consider it appropriate to reduce the penalty to the extent of Rs. 1,50,000/- each with no consequent penalty. The penalty amount of Rs.1,50,000/- and the undertaking as envisaged in the impugned order shall be deposited/submitted within four (04) weeks, failing which the impugned order shall stand revived.
