**RENEWED EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE**

In pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 5 read with Section 9 of the Competition Act, 2010 (the Act), the Competition Commission of Pakistan (the Commission) hereby grants template exemption from the application of Section 4 of the Act, details whereof are given here below:-

**Details of the Agreement:**

First Party: **M/s. Al-Ghazi Tractors Limited (hereinafter referred to as the 'Company')**

Second Party: **Standard Dealership Agreement executed with 81 dealers**

Type of Agreement: **Standard Dealership Agreement**

Date entered into: **Different dates with different dealers**

Valid until: **Shall continue to remain in force unless it is revoked surrendered**

**Details of the Exemption:**

Exemption granted to: Non-Compete and Territorial Exclusivity clauses of the agreement  
Granted until: **31-07-2022**  
Condition(s):

- i. The Exemption certificate, shall in no way be construed as an approval for fixation or maintaining 'Minimum Retail Price' with reference to the products' subject matter of the Standard Dealership Agreement;
- ii. This Certificate shall take effect upon provision of the proof of Intimation to the other party(s) to the agreement. In case, the Proof of intimation is not provided to the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of the issuance of the certificate, the Certificate shall be deemed withdrawn with immediate effect;
- iii. Any change in the terms and conditions of the Standard Dealership agreement shall be intimated to the Commission, once materialized;
- iv. Regardless of any updates in the list of agents, it shall be provided to the Commission on semi-annually basis;
- v. The Commission reserves the right to impose any condition(s) at the time of considering extension, if any; and
- vi. Breach of a condition shall have the effect of cancellation of the exemption.

Without prejudice to the generality of Section 6 of the Act, the grantee of the exemption shall inform the Commission forthwith and seek clearance for continuation of the exemption if there is any material change, *inter alia*, in: (i) the terms of the agreement; (ii) the market share of the parties to the agreement; or (iii) the circumstances in the market in which the parties are operating
