RENWED EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE

In pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 5 read with Section 9 of the Competition Act, 2010 (the Act), the Competition Commission of Pakistan (the Commission) hereby grants template exemption from the application of Section 4 of the Act, details whereof are given here below:-

Details of the Agreement:

First Party: **M/s. HINOPAK MOTORS LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as 'Company')**

Second Party: **Standard Authorized 3-S Dealership Agreement executed with 06 dealers**

Type of Agreement: **Standard Authorized 3-S Dealership Agreement**

Date entered into: **July 1st, 2005 and extended on February 22nd, 2019**

Valid until: **March 31st 2020 and further renewable**

Details of the Exemption:

Exemption granted to: **Territorial Exclusivity clause(s) of the Agreement**

Granted until: **31-03-2022**

Condition(s):

- i. The Exemption certificate, shall in no way be construed as an approval for fixation or maintaining 'Minimum Retail Price' with reference to the products under the Standard Authorized 3-S Dealership Agreement;
- ii. The Applicant shall provide copy(s) of the other agreement(s) executed or intended to be executed with respect to business activities, apart from the Standard Authorized 3-S Dealership Agreement;
- iii. This Certificate shall take effect upon provision of the proof of Intimation to the other party(s) to the agreement. In case, the Proof of intimation is not provided to the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of the issuance of the certificate, the Certificate shall be deemed withdrawn with immediate effect;
- iv. Any amendments made in the Standard Authorized 3-S Dealership Agreement shall intimate to the Commission, once materialized;
- v. The Commission reserves the right to impose any condition(s) at the time of considering extension, if any for this certificate or before the expiry of the instant certificate;
- vi. Breach of a condition shall have the effect of cancellation of the exemption.

Without prejudice to the generality of Section 6 of the Act, the grantee of the exemption shall inform the Commission forthwith and seek clearance for continuation of the exemption if there is any material change, *inter alia*, in: (i) the terms of the agreement; (ii) the market share of the parties to the agreement; or (iii) the circumstances in the market in which the parties are operating.
