"CCP discourages use of word 'Big Four' in commercial agreements"

Appointing firms: CCP discourages use of 'Big Four' term in agreements

The Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP), in its recent decisions, has explicitly discouraged the practice of using the term 'Big Four' in commercial covenants for appointing the firms for assurance or financial services.

The term 'Big Four' refers to the four large firms that offer assurance, consulting, financial advisory, risk management, and tax services, globally as well as locally.

The Commission made this observation while reviewing the application from MNT Halan Pak B V and later in another application from Advans S A SICAR. Both applicants, while seeking exemptions on certain restrictive clauses in their agreements entered into with third parties, had used the term 'Big Four' for engaging of financial and other services.

The CCP has explicated that the selection process for any financial or assurance services should not be specified or limited to the 'Big Four' in agreements.

Pertinent to refer that use of any term or condition that is inherently restrictive and impedes open and fair competition in the relevant market is not admissible under the Competition Law.

In both cases, the CCP therefore issued directives that selection process for financial or assurance services should not be limited to the 'Big Four' as it undermines fair competition and could distorts the competitive landscape for these services.

Presently, the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) maintains a list of 130 CA firms with satisfactory Quality Control Review (QCR) ratings. The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) maintains a panel of 46 auditors under Section 35(1) of the Banking Companies Ordinance, 1962, categorized into three categories A, B and C. Furthermore, Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) has an approved list of auditors pursuant to section 48 of Insurance Ordinance for audit of insurance and takaful entities.

Notably, none of these lists have specified or implied the use of the term 'Big Four' either. Under the Competition Act, 2010, limiting the provision of services to a selected group of undertakings violates the principles of open and fair competition.

Through its directions in both the above cases, the CCP has upheld and emphasized fostering open competition across all spheres of commercial and economic activities in the country. Besides, CCP underscores the importance of transparent and open selection processes to ensure a level playing field for all firms in the relevant market.

CCP discourages use of word 'Big Four' in commercial agreements

The Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP) has strongly discouraged the use of the term 'Big Four' in commercial agreements concerning the appointment of firms for assurance and financial services. This decision aims to promote fair competition within the industry.

The term 'Big Four' typically refers to the four major firms that provide assurance, consulting, financial advisory, risk management and tax services both globally and locally. The CCP's stance was highlighted during its review of applications from MNT Halan Pak BV and Advans SA SICAR, both of which sought exemptions for certain restrictive clauses in their agreements. These clauses had explicitly mentioned the use of the term 'Big Four' for engaging financial and other services.

In its ruling, the CCP said that the selection process for financial or assurance services should not be confined to the Big Four, as such restrictions undermine fair competition and distort the market landscape. The commission clarified that any term or condition that inherently limits competition is not permissible under the Competition Law.

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) maintains a list of 130 chartered accounting firms with satisfactory quality control review (QCR) ratings. Similarly, the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) has a panel of 46 auditors categorized into three tiers under Section 35(1) of the Banking Companies Ordinance, 1962. The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) also maintains an approved list of auditors for the audit of insurance and takaful entities. None of these lists specify or imply the use of the term 'Big Four'.

Under the Competition Act of 2010, limiting services to a selected group of firms contravenes the principles of open and fair competition. Through its directives in recent cases, the CCP has reaffirmed its commitment to fostering competition across all sectors of commercial and economic activity in the country. The commission has underscored the necessity of transparent and open selection processes to ensure a level playing field for all firms operating in the market.

CCP discourages 'Big Four' being used in financial service agreements

The Competition Commission of Pakistan has discouraged firms from using the term "Big Four" in commercial agreements for financial or assurance services as it refers to four dominant worldwide firms, which provide services like assurance, consulting, financial advisory, risk management, and tax services.

The CCP raised objections to this aspect when granting exemptions to the parties in respective applications under MNT Halan Pak B.V. and Advans S.A. SICAR, both of which had requested some derogations of certain restrictive clauses of respective agreements. In each of those agreements, it was agreed that the services would be drawn only from the "Big Four." The CCP clarified that such an approach violates the above principle of non openness in terms of competition.

Any terms which would limit or restrict competition in the market are not admissible under the Competition Law of Pakistan. The Commission had ordered that financial services agreements should not confine the selection process to these firms because a fair level of competition with this restriction is not achievable, and it hampers the market as well.

Now, the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP), the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), and the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) maintain approved lists of qualified auditors.
