Govt re-appoints Dr Joseph as CCP member

Made acting chairman until further orders

The federal government has re-appointed Dr Joseph Wilson as member Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP) for a term of three years with effect from November 12, 2013 and, through a separate notification, appointed him as chairman on acting charge basis, with effect from the same date and until further orders.

Dr Joseph Wilson has been serving as a founding member of CCP since its establishment in 2007. He has supervised monopolies and trade abuses, mergers & acquisitions, international affairs, strategic policy, research and exemptions departments at the Commission.

Prior to joining the Commission, he was an Associate Professor of Law at the Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS), where he taught "competition law" in addition to other courses.

He has made presentations at various international conferences, published in international law journals and authored a book titled "Globalization and the Limits of National Merger Control Laws (published by Kluwer Law International). Dr Wilson earned Doctor of Civil Law (D.C.L.) with Deans Honour List and Master of Laws (LL.M.) degrees from McGill University, Montreal, Canada. He also holds an LL.M. from the University of Georgia, USA.

He is a member of the State Bar of New York, USA and Lahore High Court Bar, and also serves on the International Advisory Board of the Loyola University Chicago's Institute for Consumer Antitrust Studies, USA. ISLAMABAD: The federal government has re-appointed Dr Joseph Wilson as Member, Competition Commission of Pakistan (CCP), for a term of three years with effect from November 12, 2013, and through a separate notification, appointed him as Chairman on acting charge basis, with effect from 12 November, 2013 and until further orders.

Commenting on the appointment of Dr Joseph Wilson as CCP Chairman, Saad Amanullah Khan, President American Business Council of Pakistan, termed it as a very positive decision of the government towards the promotion of healthy business environment and competitive practices among the business community.

Dr Wilson appointed CCP acting chief

ISLAMABAD: The government has on Wednesday appointed Dr Joseph Wilson as the acting Chairman of the Competition Commission of Pakistan.

The decision followed the exclusion of the CCP from the purview of the federal commission for the selection of heads.

A CCP's announcement said the government re-appointed Dr Wilson as member CCP for three years with effect from 12 November, 2013. And, through a separate notification, the government appointed him as acting chairman with effect from the same date till further orders.

The commission remained dysfunctional in the last few months, while the government was grilled for not making crucial appointments in the commission, especially in the wake of an ambitious privatisation plan.

According to the CCP, with the appointment of Dr Wilson, the commission is now fully operational.

The government has already re-appointed Mueen Batlay and Dr Shehzad Ansar as members of the commission for three years.

Dr Wilson has been serving as a founding member of the CCP since its establishment in 2007. He has supervised monopolies and trade abuses, mergers and acquisitions, international affairs, strategic policy and research and exemption departments.

Prior to joining the commission, he was an Associate Professor of Law at the Lahore University of Management Sciences, where he taught competition law and other courses. He has presented at various international conferences, published in international
